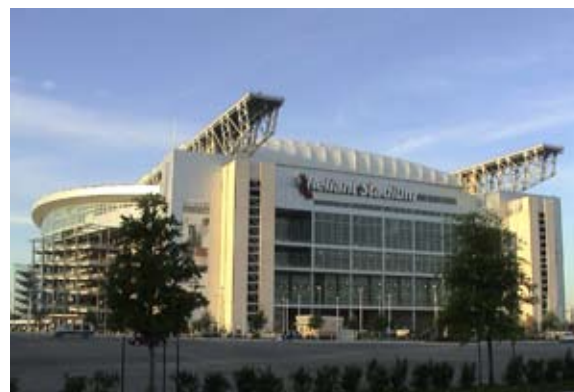

SMG's experience with new construction and expansions is unsurpassed in the facilities industry. We are the only company with a dedicated corporate support staff of planning and pre-opening specialists with substantial stadium, arena, convention center and theater experience.

Design, Planning and Programming Services:

SMG will work directly with project architects, consultants, contractors, and other vendors to achieve an aesthetically pleasing and operationally efficient facility. We will identify concerns and issues regarding the facility's program and its design and construction. Specifically, SMG is prepared to perform the following tasks, as appropriate, given the timing/status of the project.

Prior to construction, we will:

- Provide a Design Review
- Conduct a Space Planning Review

Once construction has commenced, SMG will conduct and implement a review for:

- Utilities
- Keying Systems
- Security System/CCTV
- Kitchen and Concessions

Additional Services

Operating Budget Preparation and Audit:

SMG will consult with the project finance consultants on development and/or audit of operating budgets and cash flow forecasts based on market and facility characteristics and our extensive database. This involves reviewing/forecasting all event projections including attendance, ticket/rent revenues, concession per cap estimates, other revenue source assumptions, all staffing assumptions, and indirect and start-up expense assumptions.

Pre-Opening Public Relations:

- Design a public relations campaign
- Create a calendar of significant events such as ground breakings, first brick, topping off and other significant photo and media opportunities
- Develop marketing, press and sales materials
- Conduct advertising campaigns

Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment Services:

SMG will implement a process for completing FF&E, and if requested, the food and beverage, requirements of the facility which includes four phases which include the following:

- **Programming Phase:**
 - Develop a basic format and time schedule for the FF&E service
 - Recommend proposed FF&E inventory and assist the architects with recommendations for the proposed budget
 - Review existing inventory to determine compatibility
- **Specification Phase:**
 - For all non-affixed (loose) requirements set forth detailed specifications and other documents for fabrication and procurement.
- **Procurement Phase:**
 - Provide consultation in the final bidding, including the identification of potential bidders / manufacturers for all FF&E items.
- **Installation Coordination Phase:**
 - Provide assistance in verifying bid selection, delivery schedule, and installation of FF&E items.

Operating Supply Inventory:

Before the building opens its doors for the Grand Opening, SMG will recommend the necessary initial operating supply inventory. We will examine the level, amount and types of events that will be held in the facility, and will use our knowledge and contacts with industry suppliers to purchase the needed amounts of small wares and disposables. This will be an integral part of SMG's management and pre-opening services.

Creation of a Punch List:

Once the new facility is substantially completed, SMG will work with the Owner's construction management team to inspect the facility for adherence to program and specifications, as well as any damage that may have occurred. This document, referred to as a punch list, will be instrumental in the final phase of construction and final acceptance. SMG will work with the construction management team to monitor completion of these items to the Owner's satisfaction and to ensure that the new facility will be accepted in top condition.

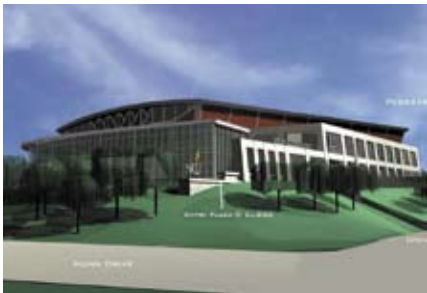
